PALOUSE SUMMER SERIES JULY 17-19, 2020 TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) There is no new inning after 2 hours and 10 minutes in all games, except the July 19th semi-final and championship games.
- 2) There is an 8 run rule after 5 innings and a 12 run rule after 4 innings in all games, except the July 19th championship game, unless otherwise agreed upon by both coaches of the championship game and the umpires during the pre-game umpire meeting.
- 3) There is a pro DH rule where the pitcher is the only position that can be DHed for.
- 4) Each team is allowed to use one Extra Hitter (EH) per game.
- 5) A slide and avoid rule will be enforced. Runner must be within arm's length of the base.
- 6) The home team book is the official game book.
- 7) Courtesy runners are allowed for catchers and pitchers only, but not mandatory.
- 8) There is no re-entry for a player removed from the lineup.
- 9) There are -3 restrictions for all bats and must be BBCOR Certified. All non -3 bats will be excluded from tournament competition.
- 10) This is a 17-under tournament. Eligible players must have been born on or after April 1, 2002. Any player born before this date is not eligible. Please be prepared to show verification of player age if questioned. Ineligible players participating in tournament games will result in forfeiture of those games participated in.
- 11) The American League Big Book covers all rules not discussed here.
- 12) Absolutely NO sunflower seeds are allowed or any other foods that encourage spitting. Players will need to be in masks anytime they're in the dugout, so they shouldn't be able to do any seed spitting.
- 13) Team listed first for each pool play game is home team and will occupy third base dugout. If playing the first game of a DH, please stay in the same dugout even if home/visitor switch.
- 14) The top two seeds from each pool will advance to Sunday's semi-final match ups. 1 Seeds will play 2 seeds at the sites listed on the schedule. 1 Seeds will be the home team. Tie breaker rules will determine who's home and away for the championship.
- 15) Tie breakers are in the following order:
 - a) Head to head
 - b) Least runs allowed
 - c) Most runs scored
 - d) Coin flip
 - *In the case of a 3 way tie where head to head cannot determine a winner, we will then follow the tie breaker order until a winner is determined. Once a winner is determined, the order of the 2 remaining teams will then be determined by returning to head to head.



- Weather or other extenuating circumstances that occur during tournament play that limit the number of games played will determine the following refund:
 - 1 game played = 25% refund
 - 2 or more games played = No refund
- McDonald Park at Colfax has two batting cages
 - If the guest cage at McDonald Park in Colfax is being used, the home team will have cage access on the home side cages an 1:15 before game time and the visiting team will have it 0:45 minutes before game time.
 - If you plan to hit wiffle balls in the grass, please use a mat for the hitter to swing on or have the players wear shoes to avoid ripping the grass up and creating holes
 - Cages will not be available for the PSS at Quann Field. Please plan to hit wiffle balls
 if batting practice is a part of your pregame.
- A dozen baseballs will be provided by the tournament with your program and passes at the
 first game. Each team will submit 2 balls to the umpire before each game and give balls
 evenly throughout the game as needed. Each team will be responsible for chasing foul
 balls and supplying balls after the dozen tournament balls are depleted.
- Fans are not allowed to enter inside the upper or lower gates at the Quann facility.
- Coaches for the championship team are responsible for picking one player from their team as the tournament MVP as soon as the tourney is over. Shortly after an MVP is determined, we'll have a brief trophy presentation for each team and the MVP.
- Players who hit a home run during any game of the tournament will receive a token for a free sundae from Dairy Queen and a coupon to Crimson and Gray. Please see the site supervisor after the game to receive your voucher.
- We will award the Sweet Mutiny Sweet Play of the Game with a free frozen yogurt coupon to Sweet Mutiny
- · Alcohol and tobacco products are not allowed at any tournament site.

INCLEMENT WEATHER OUTLINE

- The tournament director will make the ultimate decision to delay, reschedule, or cancel any tournament games, but not without consultation from any or all of the following: coaches from both teams, umpires, and site management personnel. Please keep in mind that it is in the best interest of all involved that the maximum number of tournament games is completed.
- In the event of inclement weather on any one of the tournament days, the schedule may be altered so that maximum games are played for each team as evenly as possible, with respect to the entire tournament field.
- In the event that inclement weather does cancel games before championship Sunday, the team(s) with the best record out of the round robin division play will be placed in the championship bracket. In the event that more than one team has the same record in round robin division play, the team(s) with the largest run differential will be placed in the championship bracket.
- The goal of the tournament is to ensure that the maximum number of tournament games are completed evenly by all teams and a champion is crowned on championship Sunday. The tournament director's decisions will reflect this premise.






